Some Auxiliaries have problems that impact them. Most of them are due to not using proper protocol and procedures. There are 2 books that are important for each Auxiliary and District to have available. One is the current 2022 copy "Podium Edition Bylaws and Ritual Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States Auxiliary". The other is "Roberts Rules of Order". Each of these books provide information for proper protocol and procedure. Here are a few helpful tips: 1. The President must maintain composure and control each meeting. Shouting, name calling and personal business or agenda have no place in any Auxiliary or District Meeting. They must ensure all officers are trained in their duties of their positions. Read the Bylaws and use them.

2. A Member-at-Large who is in good standing may attend an auxiliary meeting but cannot be an Officer, a delegate or vote. They should be welcomed with respect. They may attend and assist in programs.

3. A motion on the floor should be worded to be specific in nature and include all aspects of the desired result. Do not assume the result will be what you want unless you address them.

4. All members should be included in projects or asked to participate. There is always enough work to go around. You will find many people will participate even if they do not attend monthly meetings. Call them and ask for a cake, to make phone calls, to help assist in other ways.

5. There will be No bullying! Do unto others as you would have them do unto you.

6. Follow your Chain of Command! Auxiliary, District, Department President who will then go to National if deemed necessary. DO NOT go to National first. Give your department a chance.

7. All Auxiliary members should stay out of the VFW and canteen business. An auxiliary member should never be required to provide information on Auxiliary business to a VFW member without proper authorization from Department. If you are approached call our department office before you respond.

8. Communication is one of the keys to a healthy Auxiliary. Healthy Auxiliaries are the key to a successful District. Successful Districts are the key to a great department membership and effective leadership are other keys that are necessary.

9. Members voices are heard to benefit our Veterans by attendance at meetings and participation in projects and goals of the Auxiliary and the organization. Make your voice heard by being involved. When no one attends a District Meetings from the Auxiliary then they have lost their voting rights. You cannot vote if you are not there.

To next year's 2022-2023 President and Department Team, I wish you all the best and offer my full support. Have a wonderful term.
