Firstly, think about voice. Every time you post on your personal page, you are representing yourself, your views, and your experiences. When you are posting on an Auxiliary page, as an Admin, you are no longer speaking for

vourself. You are speaking for the to avoid as well – eyes closed, eating, etc. collective that is your Auxiliary. Avoid using "I" statements and giving personal opinions. Using "We" sentences or just avoiding personal pronouns in general are two ways that create the illusion that *Person* A is not speaking, but rather the Auxiliary itself is speaking.
